As a Group Manager since 2008, Carl has led a number of district service delivery teams, which included an appointment as Vice Chairman of the Craven, Hambleton and Richmondshire Community Safety Partnerships, working alongside our partners on a number of community safety issues and initiatives. Carl has also held the posts of Section Head for the Staff Risk and Operational Assurance teams where he worked closely with the North Yorkshire Local Resilience Forum (NYLRF) as Chairman of the Training and Exercising Group.

Carl is currently in post as an Area Manager and is the Services strategic lead for the Joint Emergency Services Interoperability Programme (JESIP) with involvement in a number of regional and national working groups related to his areas of responsibility. He is based at our Service Headquarters in Northallerton, which is also his home town.
